
Our Very own Joe Theismann was inducted into the New Jersey Hall of Fame On

Here is what the program had to say about the accomplished and admirable, Joe:

"One of the greatest quarterbacks in Washington Redskins history, Joe Theismann grew up in South River, New Jersey where he excelled in three sports and in the classroom. At Notre Dame, he set many school records and became both a Football All-American and an Academic All-American. He just missed winning the Heisman Trophy in 1971 and went on to All-Star years in the Canadian Football League before moving to the NFL.

His 12 seasons with The Redskins included two Super Bowl appearances, a Super Bowl victory, two Pro Bowls and an MVP Award. His career was terminated by one of the most famous tackles in football history, but it opened the door to a career in broadcasting. He is known not only from his success on the field but also from his commentary on CBS, ESPN and The NFL Network. He is in The College Football Hall of Fame, was named NFL Man of the Year for community service and is a much sought after motivational speaker."
